Kendis Paris is the executive director and co-



founder of Truckers Against Trafficking, a 501(c)3 organization that exists to educate, equip, empower and mobilize members of the trucking and travel plaza industry to combat domestic sex trafficking. Co-winner of the Norma Hotaling Award for demand

reduction, Kendis is also an Ashoka (a-show-ka) fellow, a global organization that identifies and invests in leading social entrepreneurs.

Glen Parks graduated from UNL-Law in 2001 and initially worked as a litigator at a full service business law firm in Lincoln. In 2006 he and his family moved to India to co-found a law-focused, anti-human trafficking organization and to serve as its legal director. He and his family spent a total of nine years in India, returning to Nebraska in 2015. At that point he clerked for a Nebraska Supreme Court justice for one year and then joined the Nebraska Attorney General's Office in August 2016 to assist in the formation and operation of the state-wide human trafficking task force.
