Welcome!

The Nebraska Trucking Association's Safety Management Council welcomes you to the Nebraska Truck Driving Championship on May 31 through June 1, 2024 in Grand Island. This annual event showcases the state's finest drivers and the world-class companies these drivers represent. To register drivers, your company must be a member of the Nebraska Trucking Association. You may enter a maximum of five drivers in each class of competition. Drivers must compete in the class indicated on their official entry.

All paperwork and fees must be received by the Nebraska Trucking Association at 1701 K St, Lincoln, NE 68508 NO LATER THAN **May 1, 2024**, or driver(s) will not be eligible to compete.

To be eligible, employee drivers and permanent-lease owner-operators:

- must have an accident-free record for the 12 months preceding May 31, 2024
- must have been employed by your company during the same time
- must have driven for your company at least 11 of the past 12 months
- must be a permanent resident of Nebraska or must report to a terminal domiciled in Nebraska
- must have appropriate class of CDL, and any required endorsements, for the class in which they compete

Return this "2024 NTDC Registration Form" AND:

- the other attached form called "2024_NTDC_Driver" – one per driver
- copy of a current MVR (**dated after April 1, 2024**) – one per driver
- a \$35 fee (this fee DOES NOT include meal tickets) – one per driver

Once NTA receives all necessary forms and fees, you will receive two championship shoulder patches and a 2024 Facts for Drivers book for each driver. Questions for the written exam will be taken from this book.

Headquarters hotel Ramada Wyndham Midtown in Grand Island can accommodate most participants and volunteers. However, there's still a good chance the hotel will sell out long before the event. At the championships, the drivers will participate in:

- a written test to demonstrate their knowledge of regulations and safety
- a personal interview to show their ability to represent your company
- a pre-trip inspection to display their equipment safety awareness
- a driving course to demonstrate their driving skills on key challenges faced daily
- Champions in each class may advance to American Trucking Associations' Championships, Aug. 21-24 in Indianapolis, IN!

Incentives

First, second and third place winners in each class receive trophies. Additional awards are given to the drivers who achieve the highest scores on the written test, pre-trip, and driving skills portions of the competition. We also recognize a Grand Champion, a Rookie of the Year, Professional Excellence award recipient, Jerry Wessel All-Around Driver, Kurt Everett Vehicle Condition award recipient, R.J." Bucky" Buchholz Top Driver award recipient, and a team title earned by the company with the highest average score. A company must have at least three drivers to be considered for the team award.

Practice rules

A driver may not practice on company time or be paid for practice time. Violation will disqualify the driver from the championships. You may, at your option, elect to pay the driver for an actual working day spent in competition and/or reimburse expenses for the driver and his or her spouse at the championships. You are urged to adhere to the practice of not paying drivers for normal off-duty hours. If the Saturday of the championships is a driver's regular day off, he or she should not be paid for Saturday. A driver may not compete in any vehicle that he or she has practiced with or driven prior to competition. Violation will disqualify the driver from the championships.

Championship Classes

- Straight truck driver needs Class A, B or C License
- Three-, four-, five-axle, five-axle sleeper berth and five-axle flatbed driver needs Class A License
- Five-axle tank driver needs Class A License with N or X endorsements
- Twin trailers driver needs Class A License with T endorsement
- Step van driver can be a CDL or non-CDL driver
- Concrete Mixer driver needs Class A or B License

Our simple forms can be quickly tabbed through as you fill in the blanks.

- Why do we need a List of Drivers Form? Because it helps companies and NTDC organize finances and drivers and points to one company contact for information.
- Why do we need a Meal Ticket Form? To ensure everyone has enough food and to ensure NTDC doesn't overspend. With the form, we can also itemize meal costs and allow for special diets.
- Why do we need Announcer Information History found on "2024 NTDC Driver" form? To engage the crowds and provide some talking points during the driving skills test, we ask for personal/background information. It's like the way announcers prepare for golf or football games.
- Why do we ask for a Sponsor Form and Volunteer Forms? Company representatives who register drivers are often the same people who organize sponsors and volunteers for the event. Without this type of help, NTDC wouldn't be such a valuable and popular event.
- Why do we need ATA Championship forms? Additional driver information, disclaimers and the driver's signature are found here.

AGREEMENTS AND RELEASE

In consideration of my being permitted to participate in the ATA's National and/or its affiliates' Truck Driving Championships (TDC) or Step Van Driving Championships (SVDC) and be eligible for awards offered to participants, I hereby stipulate and agree to the following:

1. I acknowledge that I am not in the employ of ATA or a State Trucking Association.
2. Both as to myself and my heirs and personal representatives, I release ATA, its directors, employees, agents and/or any of its affiliates and the State Association noted above, its directors, employees, agents and/or any of its affiliates from any and all liability and any right of action that may arise from any damage or injury which I may receive while attending or participating in said State or National TDC or National SVDC.
3. I grant the State Association listed to the left and ATA and its designated agencies exclusive right to make use of information about myself and of photographs supplied with this entry form, along with photographs subsequently taken under ATA's direction, in publicity and advertising activities. I further agree to make myself available for publicity enterprises arranged by ATA, with newspaper and magazine writers and radio and television personnel.
4. I grant State Association listed to the left and ATA the right to examine my MVR for the purposes of determining my eligibility to compete at both the State and National TDC or SVDC.
5. I will be bound by all orders, rules and regulations governing ATA's National and/or its affiliates' TDC or SVDC while participating in said competitions.

CERTIFICATION BY CONTESTANT.

 I certify that:

1. I have been continuously employed as a truck or step van driver by my present employer during the 12 months prior to the 2024 TDC.
2. I have driven and performed the regular duties of a truck or step van driver during the 12 months prior to the 2024 TDC.
3. I have not been away from the regular duties of a professional truck driver beyond an aggregate of 30 calendar days during the 12 months prior to the 2024 TDC.
4. I have not been involved in a **Preventable** fleet motor vehicle or motor carrier vehicle accident during the 12 months prior to the 2024 TDC. See TDC Rules and Procedures, Appendix I for determining non-preventable accident eligibility.
5. I have the proper class CDL or DL plus required endorsement(s) for the class of competition indicated to the left.
6. I hold a CDL (DL if SVDC) from or have been occupationally domiciled in the state of _____.
Occupational domiciled is defined as the terminal, garage or other operating base from which the driver normally works, is supervised and/or where employer is corporately headquartered.
7. I have not served as a member of any State Trucking Associations Truck Driving Championships Committee since January 1, 2024.
8. That the class of competition I am entering in 2024 is not a class in which I won at the state or regional TDC and/or competed at the National TDC or National SVDC in 2022 and 2023. I understand that after winning two consecutive years at the State TDC and/or competing two consecutive years at the Nationals in that same class of competition, I am not eligible to compete in that same class for one year if a step van competitor and two years if a competitor in any other class.
9. I have not received any form of pay, bonus, prize or other consideration for time spent in practice as set forth in the Truck Driving Championships Rules & Procedures. I agree that if I compete and win the State TDC, that I will compete at the National TDC or SVDC (as applicable), unless disqualified or am detained due to a medical emergency, in which case I will notify the applicable State Trucking Association immediately. I acknowledge that any misstatement made with respect to my eligibility for the TDC or SVDC competition may result in the forfeiture of my right to compete or in my disqualification from said competition.
